



## West Region Receives More Supplies From Province

**April 28, 2020** - The Ontario Health West Region has received a third shipment of personal protective equipment (PPE) from the province. This allocation consists of the following:

- Disinfectant Wipes – 700,000+
- Gloves – 4,100,000+
- Level 1 Gowns – 200,000
- Level 2 Surgical Masks – 140,000

Providers within the following sectors have access to this one-time allocation for urgent PPE requests:

- Hospitals
- Long-Term Care Homes
- Retirement Homes
- Home Care Providers
- Primary Care Providers, specifically serving vulnerable populations (e.g. Community Health Clinics, Aboriginal Health Access Centres, inner city clinics, clinics serving refugee populations, etc.)
- Mental Health and Addictions Providers
- Homes for Special Care
- Community Service Providers

Urgent requests for PPE supplies should continue to be made by completing the [online order form](#). Supplies will continue to be distributed in accordance with the allocation formula established by the Ontario Health West Region Allocation Committee.
